STIPULATION AND ORDER **GRANTING PERMANENT** INJUNCTION

## I. STIPULATION

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by the undersigned attorneys for Plaintiff Veterans For Peace and Defendant City of Auburn ("the City") that the City and its officers, agents, servants, and employees will not apply any rules, regulations, or decisions regarding Veterans For Peace's participation in the City's Veterans Day Parade in a viewpoint discriminatory manner. Subject to meeting the same basic requirements as any other parade participant, the City must grant Veterans For Peace participant status in any future City sponsored Veterans Day parades.

The parties, having negotiated in good faith, respectfully ask that the Court enter 1 2 a permanent injunction to resolve the claims in the above-captioned matter. 3 So Stipulated this 13th day of December 2012. 4 5 Daniel B. II. ORDER

Based upon the foregoing stipulation, this Court enters the following Permanent Injunction:

The City of Auburn and its officers, agents, servants, and employees are hereby enjoined from applying any rules, regulations, or decisions regarding Veterans For Peace's participation in the Parade in a viewpoint discriminatory manner. Subject to meeting the same basic requirements as any other parade participant, the City of Auburn must grant Veterans For Peace participant status in any future City sponsored Veterans Day parades.

Nothing in this Order shall be deemed to compel the City of Auburn to conduct a Veterans Day Parade in the future.

This injunction shall automatically dissolve five years from date of entry, unless Veterans For Peace files a written objection with the Court stating that it still believes that it and its members' right to free speech is still at risk. The City may choose to respond to the objection and file a motion to vacate the injunction at that time. If the City fails to file a response and motion to vacate, this injunction will remain in place for another five years. If the City does file a response and motion to vacate, the Court shall decide if the injunction will remain in place for another five years. If the Injunction is so extended, at the end of the ten years, this injunction will be dissolved automatically, unless Plaintiff files a Motion to Extend, and the Court grants the motion.
