4. As the supervising attorney of an office with four staff attorneys, we represent many individuals detained at the Northwest Detention Center. Someone from our staff is at the Northwest Detention Center (where the Tacoma Immigration Court is located) almost every day of the work week.

5. Bond hearings at the Tacoma Immigration Court occur almost every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.

6. Based on the experiences of our staff members in the Tacoma Immigration Court, a conservative estimate is that each of the three Immigration Judges in Tacoma hear five to eight bond hearings each day. This translates to a conservative estimate of fifteen to twenty-four bond hearings per day, or forty-five to seventy-two hearings per week.

7. I know of no case that our office has taken or any taken by any other attorney where an Immigration Judge in the Tacoma Immigration Court has granted conditional parole at a bond hearing or recognized an authority to grant conditional parole.
