Weyerhaeuser Annual Shareholder Meeting

The following is a summary of this year's Annual Shareholder Meeting. The Public Safety Department participated by maintaining the safety and security of those in attendance of the event.

Staffing

The 2006 event was held from 0600 to 1200 hours. Our department staffed the event with the following personnel:

Briefings

Individual briefings occurred on 04/19/06 two Pre-operation officers and with the motor officers. Pre-operation security deployed on 04/20/06 at 0500 hours to cover the area for banner drops and during briefing. Motor officers deployed on 04/20/06 at 0600 hours to cover briefing and the many trails throughout the property. The remainder of the units briefed on 04/20/06 at 0600 hours at Weyerhaeuser Corporate Headquarters.

Enforcement Summary

There were no arrests at this year's event. Exterior protesters peaked at approximately 15 during the event. Contact was made with the protesters and rules for the day were accepted. One contingent was interrupted attempting to deploy a banner from the 320th overpass at I5. Several subjects were turned away from the meeting without incident for having invalid/fraudulent proxy statements. Approximately 10 members or representatives of the Rainforest Action Network attended the actual meeting. The subjects were allowed to speak and remained respectful throughout the event.

Traffic Control Summary

There was no remarkable traffic incidents encountered at this year's event. The west entry to the building was blocked at 0800 hours and remained blocked until the end of the event.

Other Event Activities

WSP provided 3 officers to assist with observation at the I5 and Highway 18 overpasses.

Suggestions for Improvements

A debriefing was not held at the end of the event due to the different times that each assigned group was released. The following are suggestions to improve the event or comments made during informal debriefings:

- Conduct a Federal Way only briefing prior to arriving at Weyerhaeuser for the event.
- Use of CDU on standby for mass arrest is a good plan. They could have assisted in several different scenarios if necessary.
- Contact RAN next year prior to the event to determine the intent of their actions. Contact was made with several representatives who stated that they wanted to maintain operations "above board" and in cooperation with Law Enforcement.

Patrol Operations Graveyard Watch

Graveyard patrol was asked to assist by maintaining security on the site throughout the night. No contacts were made with potential protesters.
