181.I am a Senior Labor Negotiator in the Office of Financial Management	for the
¹⁹ State of Washington. I have had over twenty-seven years of experience in the field	of labor
²⁰ relations, and have successfully negotiated more than 200 collective bargaining agreer	nents in
21 both the public and private sectors. Through my experience, I have developed an e	xcellent
²² understanding of labor relations rules, principles and concepts in labor law, as well the	relevant
²³ regulatory bodies.	
24 2. As part of my experience, I served as the state's lead negotiator thro	ugh the
²⁵ historic rounds of home care worker bargaining with the Service Employees Inter	national
26	

Union that began in 2002. I later served as the Executive Director of the Washington State 1 Home Care Quality Authority. In 2011, I was appointed to the position of Washington State 2 3 Director of Labor Relations, which I held until my retirement in 2013. I returned in late 2015 4 to assist labor relations efforts at Western State Hospital for the Office of Financial Management. I first began working for the State of the Washington in 1981, and have served at 5 the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS), the Office of Financial Management 6 and the Department of Revenue. I am a graduate of Pacific Lutheran University, and hold a 7 B.A. in Political Science. 8

9 3. I led the DSHS negotiations with the Union of Physicians of Washington
10 (UPW). The negotiations were in response to the UPW Demand to Bargain on several issues
11 that arose with respect to the forensic wards at Western State Hospital.

4. As indicated by the attached letter that I sent to counsel for the UPW on April
13, 2016, the negotiations were successfully concluded with the following outcomes:

a. DSHS will contract for physician services on four "not guilty by reason of insanity" (NGRI) wards that are currently provided by WSH employees, as those wards have generally static populations. The NGRI ward with older and more fragile patients will not be included in the contracting proposal; however, DSHS reserves the right to contract for psychiatric and/or medical services in the future for that ward if the psychiatrist leaves.

b. The contracted services may include alternative delivery methods, such as telepsychiatry, as well as the use of ARNPs and PAs, based upon vendor proposals and the established standards of care and CMS Conditions of Participation.

c. WSH will continue to aggressively recruit and hire psychiatrists to fill vacancies, current and future, with state employees.

d. State employee psychiatrists currently assigned to impacted NGRI wards may select from current vacancies and will be given preference for those positions.
