The American Civil Liberties Union of Washington ("ACLU") respectfully moves, pursuant to RAP 10.1(e) and 10.6, to file a brief as *Amicus Curiae* regarding whether closed containers may be opened while conducting an inventory of an impounded vehicle. In support of this motion, *amicus* offers the following information:

I. <u>IDENTITY AND INTEREST OF AMICUS</u>

The American Civil Liberties Union of Washington ("ACLU") is a statewide, nonpartisan, nonprofit organization of over 80,000 members and supporters, dedicated to the preservation of civil liberties, including privacy. The ACLU strongly supports adherence to the provisions of Article 1, Section 7 of the Washington State Constitution, prohibiting unreasonable interference in private affairs. It has participated in numerous privacy-related cases as *amicus curiae* or as counsel to parties.

II. FAMILIARITY WITH ISSUE

Amicus has obtained copies of, and is familiar with, the briefing submitted by the parties to this Court, the opinions of the Court of Appeals, and the proceedings below. Amicus is familiar with the scope of the argument presented by the parties and will not unduly repeat arguments raised by any of the parties.

III. <u>ISSUE TO BE ADDRESSED BY AMICUS</u>

Whether opening a closed container without a warrant during an inventory search disturbs private affairs without authority of law, in violation of Article 1, Section 7.

IV. WHY AMICUS BRIEFING WILL ASSIST THE COURT

The Court's decision on the issues in this case will significantly impact the law on searches of impounded vehicles. A fully informed decision from Washington's highest court is essential, and the additional argument provided by *amicus* will be helpful to the Court. RAP 10.6(a). The parties are naturally most interested in establishment of a rule that addresses the particular facts of this case and provides a favorable result to their clients. *Amicus* can provide a wider perspective, helping in the establishment of a rule that goes beyond the needs of the specific parties in this case.

V. <u>CONCLUSION</u>

For the foregoing reasons, the ACLU respectfully requests that the Court grant leave to file the attached *amicus* brief.
