- 1. I am a licensed attorney in the State of Washington and I am currently the Chief Deputy of the Pierce County Department of Assigned Counsel. Our office provides indigent criminal defense to those charged in various jurisdictions within Pierce County, including Pierce County Superior Court. Our office employs approximately 75 attorneys, with approximately 26 attorneys currently assigned to Superior Court. One of my duties as Chief Deputy is to oversee and manage all of the attorneys employed at the Department of Assigned Counsel.
- 2. The Superior court attorneys at my office represent approximately 20 clients who are currently incarcerated at the Pierce County Jail, and who have been found incompetent to proceed on their underlying criminal case, and who have been ordered to Western State Hospital for restoration treatment.
- Over the last thirty days, the average time incompetent clients have remained incarcerated in the Pierce County Jail while awaiting transport to Western State Hospital for inpatient competency restoration days has been approximately sixty days.
- 4. Most recently, on September 30, 2014, Christine Shriner, the admissions coordinator for Western State Hospital, quoted an expected admission date for two of our clients currently incarcerated in the Pierce County Jail that is sixty-nine days after the 45 day restoration orders were signed and entered.
- 5. All of our clients who are currently incarcerated at the Pierce County Jail while awaiting transport to Western State Hospital are held on no-bail holds and most are held in isolation on 23 hour lock down for the period they are awaiting transport.
- 6. The Pierce County jail is not a therapeutic environment and does not provide restoration services or counseling services.
