DECLARATION OF CASSIE CORDELL TRUEBLOOD

Washington State Department of Social and Health Services; Kevin Quigley, in his official capacity as Secretary of the Department of Social and Health Services; Western State Hospital; Ron Adler in his official capacity as Chief Executive Officer of Western State Hospital; Eastern State Hospital; and Dorothy Sawyer in her official capacity as Chief Executive Officer of Eastern State Hospital,

I, Cassie Cordell Trueblood, declare as follows:

- 1. I am over the age of eighteen, have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein, and am competent to testify thereto.
- 2. I am licensed to practice law in Washington State. I represent indigent criminal defendants as a public defender. I am employed by the Snohomish County Public Defender

Association (SCPDA), which represents the vast majority of indigent criminal defendants prosecuted in Snohomish County, Washington.

- 3. I am the duly appointed attorney for A.B. I represent A.B. in connection with a charge of Assault in the Third Degree. A.B. is alleged to have slapped a police officer, causing no serious or lasting physical injury.
- 4. I am also A.B.'s next friend in this litigation. I am aware that this litigation is being pursued as a class action. I am aware of my obligations, should this case be certified as a class action and I be appointed as a class representative.
- 5. I know A.B. to suffer from severe mental illness. She is unable to hold a rational conversation for more than a few seconds. While in Snohomish County Jail, A.B. declined to take any medications, to wash herself, or to otherwise protect her most basic survival needs.
- 6. A.B. was put in Snohomish County Jail on July 2, 2014. From July 2, 2014 to August 8, then again from August 20 to August 22, 2014, A.B. was held in a solitary confinement cell in Snohomish County Jail pending transportation to Western State Hospital (WSH) for competency restoration treatment. From August 11 to August 20, 2014, she was held in the emergency room of Providence Hospital, Colby Campus.
- 7. Attached to the Declaration as Exhibit A is a true and accurate copy of Defendants' official report on A.B.'s mental condition, finding that she is legally incompetent.
- 8. Attached to this Declaration as Exhibit B is a true and accurate copy of the trial court's July 2, 2014 order requiring Defendants to transport A.B. for competency restoration treatment at WSH.
- 9. Attached to this Declaration as Exhibit C is a true and accurate copy of Dr. Brian Waiblinger's sworn declaration, dated July 30, 2014, regarding the timeline for transporting A.B.

to WSH for competency restoration treatment. Dr. Waiblinger is the Medical Director for Western State Hospital.

- 10. Attached to this Declaration as Exhibit D is a true and accurate copy of Brian Waiblinger's July 25, 2014 sworn testimony regarding Defendants' policies for transporting and treating legally incompetent patients.
 - 11. A.B. was finally transported to Western State Hospital on August 22, 2014.
