- I, Mark Adair, declare as follows:
- 1. I am over the age of eighteen, have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein, and am competent to testify thereto.
- 2. I am a lawyer in the felony division of The Defender Association Division (TDAD) of the King County Office of Public Defense, where I have worked since February 2001.
 - 3. Currently, I represent C.C.
- 4. C.C. is in custody at the Regional Justice Center. He is charged with Residential Burglary and Assault in the Second Degree.

- 5. On October 8, 2014, C.C. was ordered to undergo a competency evaluation. Attached as Exhibit A is a true and accurate copy of Order for Competency Evaluation.
- 6. On October 22, 2014, C.C. was found incompetent and ordered to undergo restoration at Western State Hospital ("WSH"). Attached as Exhibit B is a true and accurate copy of Order finding Defendant Incompetent and Committing for First Restoration Period.
- 7. According to testimony by WSH, in a different case involving an individual awaiting competency restoration services, the current wait time for felony competency restoration is approximately sixty-five days.
- 8. C.C. remains in custody in the Regional Justice Center and is awaiting treatment.
- 9. He has now served more time than he would if he could accept the State's offer to plead guilty to two misdemeanors and accept the State's offer of time served. The State made that offer on July 16, 2014.
- 10. C.C. is in lockdown 23 hours a day and I believe that his mental health has deteriorated as a result of the time he has spent at the Regional Justice Center.
