This letter explained to Plaintiffs' counsel that the USCIS A-files provided with Defendants' Initial Disclosures were incomplete due to the fact that they had been provided to Defendants' counsel prior to the completion of the FBI name checks, and were therefore out of date. Updated copies of the A-files were provided to Plaintiffs' counsel with the letter, along with a copy of the FBI's administrative record for this case. Defendants also responded to Plaintiffs' First Discovery Requests on February 19, 2008.

4. The documents provided to Plaintiffs' counsel on February 19, 2008
included documents related to the FBI name checks for the individual plaintiffs.
However, the results of the name checks were redacted pursuant to the law enforcement privilege.
